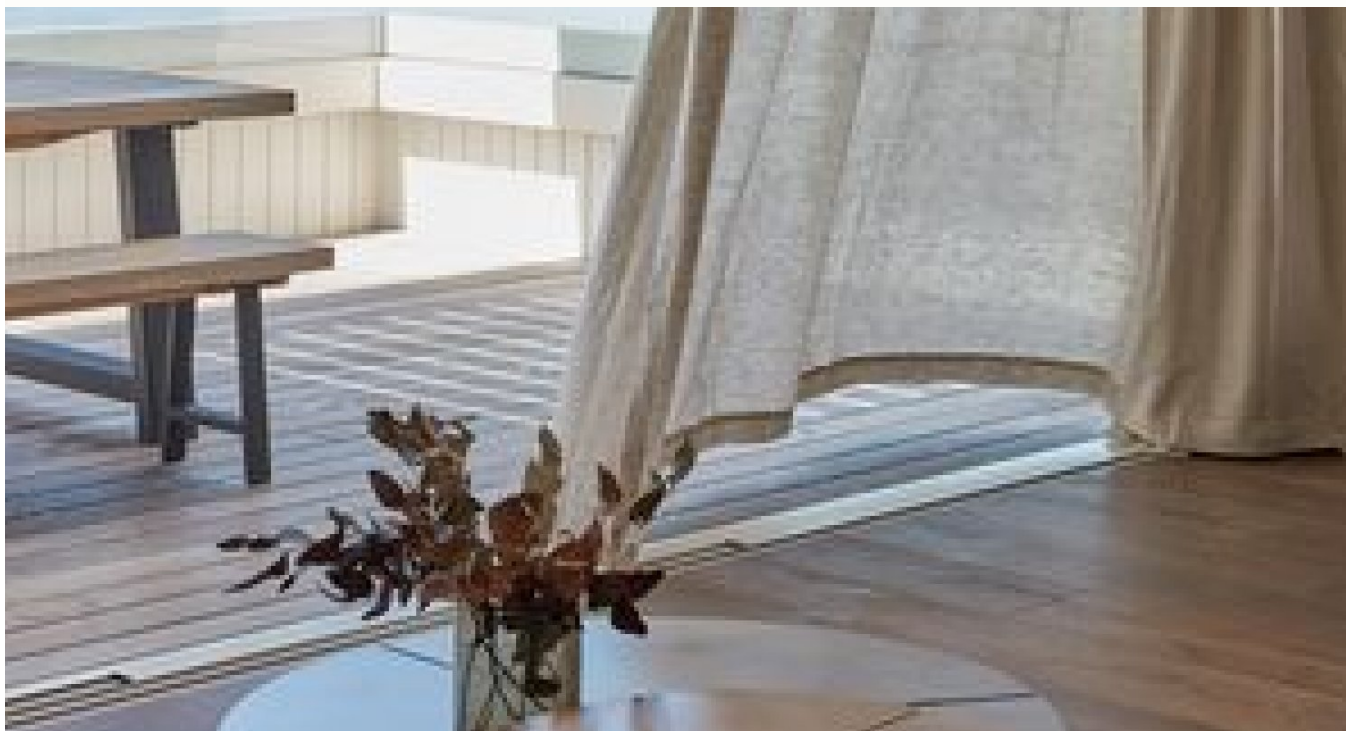


Refreshing Window Trends from Lahood® For Spring

Double the Effect: A strong trend for windows is the combination of curtain sheers with blackout roller blinds to allow natural light during the day and privacy at night. If space or preference do not allow for sheers, dual roller blinds will achieve a similar effect with a sunscreen providing light and UV protection during the day and a blackout blind providing darkness and privacy at night. Automated window blinds are more popular than ever, and can be programmed to open and close depending on the time or temperature within your home.
